Issues of concern that the Subcommittee would like to discuss would be financial review of the Police department and operation, community policing initiatives, short term and long term strategic planning.

The meetings will be bi-monthly and conducted in an informal setting so as to encourage frank, open discussion and expression of opinions by participants. The Committee will report to the Council relevant issues raised and/or subjects that may require more extensive investigation that Committee resources allow.
