SUBJECT: Waterfront Park Public Workshop

DISCUSSION:

The Parks, Recreation, Marina and Cultural Commission (PRMCC) is hosting a public workshop. The goal of the workshop is to help guide the planning and design process for the improvement of Waterfront Park. Waterfront Park is the largest community recreation park in the City of Martinez. It is the site of softball tournaments, the Fourth of July and a number of special events such as the Beer Fest and King of the County Bar-B-Que. In addition it serves many general recreation functions such as group picnic, family picnic, play areas, soccer and skateboard park.

It is anticipated that this meeting will be the first of three opportunities for public comment. The second meeting will be held to review a draft plan for PRMCC approval. A third hearing will be held at a City Council meeting at which time the plan will receive final approval to proceed into document preparation for the actual park improvements construction.
