DISCUSSION:

Hidden Valley Lakes are fed from spring water and seasonal runoff. The testing of the water is performed when it becomes necessary to treat the lakes when algae, Tully Weed and Azola become a problem. This usually occurs in the spring and summer when the weather is warmer. The contractor that applies the chemical product is required by state regulations to monitor the water quality levels to ensure they are not harmful to aquatic life.
