**RECOMMENDATION:**

Motion approving a four (4) month Extension to the Agreement for Eric Ghisletta to provide Interim Chief of Police services.

**BACKGROUND:**

At the September 3, 2014 meeting of the City Council, the Council voted unanimously to appoint Eric Ghisletta as Interim Chief of Police, effective September 1 through December 31, 2014.

The original agreement is due to expire at the end of 2014 and there is a desire to extend the original agreement in order to allow the soon-to-be newly appointed City Manager an opportunity to select the permanent Chief of Police.

The provisions of the original agreement are unaffected by this extension and the original agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

There is no additional fiscal impact as the funds for the position are appropriated in the Police Department section of the City's FY14-15 operating budget.

**ACTION:**

Motion approving a four (4) month Extension to the Agreement for Eric Ghisletta to provide Interim Chief of Police services and authorizing the Mayor to execute said Extension.

**EXTENSION AND AMENDMENT OF EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT –  
INTERIM CHIEF OF POLICE**

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into at Martinez, California this 17<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2014 by and between the City of Martinez (“City”) and Eric Ghisletta (“Ghisletta” or “Employee”), with reference to the following facts:

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, Ghisletta and the City entered into an employment agreement effective September 1, 2014 (“Original Agreement”) whereby the City retained Ghisletta and Ghisletta agreed to be employed by the City as the City’s Interim Chief of Police;

WHEREAS, the Original Agreement is slated to expire on December 31, 2014, unless extended by the mutual agreement of the parties; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the Original Agreement under the following terms and conditions:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of this Agreement, and mutual promises, covenants and stipulations obtained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

**AGREEMENT**

1. The term of the Original Agreement is hereby extended for an additional four (4) months, up to and including April 30, 2015.
2. Except as expressly amended herein, the provisions of the Original Agreement shall be unaffected by the Agreement and the Original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the City of Martinez has caused this Agreement to be signed and executed in its behalf by its Mayor, and Ghisletta has signed and executed this Agreement, on the day and year first written above.
