RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt resolution accepting the Chemical Containment Facility Project (C7036) per contract documents and instruct the City Clerk to file a Notice of Completion.

BACKGROUND:

On February 20, 2013 the City Council awarded a contract to Pacific Infrastructure Corporation for the construction of the Chemical Containment Facility Project (C7036) for a bid amount of \$559,000.00. Four (4) contract change orders were issued for the project, totaling \$25,874.26. There was also an additional expenditure of \$189 for field measurements. The final cost of the project was \$585,063.26.

The project included the necessary site work and construction for a new concrete chemical containment facility at the Water Treatment Plant. Specific elements of the project included tree removal and earthwork to bring the area to final grade. In addition, there were special provisions needed to support a standby generator located adjacent to the construction site for the new facility.

Below is a summary of the four change orders. Funding for the change orders came from the project contingency.

CO#1	Additional Paving	\$ 6,728.54
CO#2	Unforeseen condition, Demo Existing wall & pour back as required to install new pipe sleeves	\$ 3,678.72
CO#3	Unforeseen condition, Locate existing water line, add additional conduit & wiring	\$ 6,215.00
CO#4	Unforeseen condition, Modify Existing Piping and Supports	\$ 9,252.00

The contractor has submitted the Contractor Guarantee and the Maintenance Bond. The contractor has also agreed to correct any defects, per specifications, for a one-year period.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The project was completed within the approved budget.




