SUBJECT: Hillside Reservoir Access Improvements Project No. C7032
DATE: March 26, 2015

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt resolution rejecting all bids for the Hillside Reservoir Access Improvement Project.

BACKGROUND:

The Hillside Reservoir Access Improvement project consists of installing approximately 400 lineal feet of grooved concrete pavement on Arabian Heights Drive to provide safe and reliable, all weather access to the Hillside Reservoir. The concrete pavement will replace the deteriorated gravel in the very steep section of the access road leading to the reservoir.

DISCUSSION:

Construction bids from three general engineering contractors were opened at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 19, 2015 for this project. The bids ranged from \$75,700 to \$105,286. All of the bids exceeded the project construction budget. Staff is recommending that, in accordance with Public Contract Code Section 20166, the bids are rejected and the project re-advertised after reevaluating the project specifications. The following is a summary of the bid results:



RESOLUTION NO. -15

REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE HILLSIDE RESERVOIR ACCESS IMPROVEMENT

WHEREAS, the Capital Improvement Plan includes the Hillside Reservoir Access Improvement, Project No. C7032 (Project); and

WHEREAS, staff prepared plans, specifications and a budget estimate for the Project; and

WHEREAS, in February 2015, the City advertised for bids for construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2015, three bids were publicly opened; and

WHEREAS, the bids exceeded the budgeted funds for the project; and

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code Section 20166 provides that the City Council, in its discretion, may reject any bids presented and re-advertise the project; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends to reject the bids and to reevaluate the project specifications; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the public and the City to reject all bids and reevaluate the specifications of the Hillside Reservoir Access Improvements Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Martinez that all bids be rejected for the Hillside Reservoir Access Improvements Project.
