Subject: May Staff Report

**ADULT SPORTS**

- Adult softball began the week of May 6. Church League has ten teams, Coed Just for Fun has seven and Men's E League has seven teams. Shell League will begin their league mid-July.

**AQUATICS**

- The Martinez Community Swim Team began swim practice May 1. Two hundred children are on the team. A new swimmer day was held Tuesday, April 30. Fifty people came by to meet the coaches and tour the pool.
- Water aerobics began May 1 and was held three days a week, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.
- Lap swimming began May 1 and is held five days a week.
- Lifeguard review class was held May 2 and May 30.
- Seven school pool parties were held the end of May and first of June.
- May Play Day was held at RAC, May 27. About thirty-seven people attended.
- A new point of sale system will now take the place of the old hard to use cash registers. The new system is easier to use and will help staff gather information quicker for end of year reports.
- Even though the entire month of May was very cold and windy, 150 brave water aerobics attended class during the month.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

- Staff has begun working on the summer playground program. Recreation Leader candidates and Counselor's-In-Training have been interviewed and hired. Weekly schedule and some craft projects completed.
- Office staff has been extremely busy with swimming, camp, program and class registrations, as well as picnic rentals and pool parties.

**PICNIC & FACILITY RENTALS**

- Two hundred and forty six picnic areas have been rented to date, almost 100 more than the previous May.

**SPECIAL EVENTS**

- Oohs, Ahs and Giggles, children's performing art series: Randal McGee and Goark the puppet – 65; Zappo the Magician – 85; Daniel Davinci 77; Boswick the Clown 75.

**TOURNAMENTS**

- Three baseball tournaments were held the month of May at Waterfront DiMaggio Ball Fields. The tournaments had sixteen to twenty-teams participating each weekend.

**YOUTH SPORTS**

- Preschool soccer had twenty-four young athletes participating through Skyhawks Sports.
