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**Recommendation**

Motion approving a resolution accepting bids for the 2015 Paving Project and awarding the construction contract to MCK Services, Inc.

**Background**

This project includes the following streets:

- Center Avenue/Pine Street at Highway 4 - resurfacing
- Morello Avenue at Highway 4 - resurfacing
- Morello Avenue - patch paving
- Arnold Drive – patch paving
- Howe Road - patch paving
- Haag Road – resurfacing
- C Street/Allen Street/Geneva Street – resurfacing/patch paving
- Arreba Street – resurfacing
- Kingston Ave./Jordan Ct./Mountain View Dr. - patch paving
- Glenview Dr. – patch paving
- Virginia Hills Drive/Waverly Drive/Donegal Drive – patch paving

**Discussion**

Construction bids from two general engineering contractors were opened at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 29, 2015. The bids ranged from \$1,087,832.90 to \$1,172,220.25. The engineer’s estimate was \$1,500,000. The following is a summary of the bid results:

Bay Cities Paving and Grading, Inc.	\$1,172,220.25

MCK Services, Inc. of Martinez is the lowest responsible bidder. They are properly licensed and have successfully completed several projects for the City and other local agencies.

It is recommended the project be awarded to MCK Services, Inc. in the amount of \$1,087,832.90. The lowest responsible bid came in lower than the engineer's estimate, by over \$400,000. This is due in large part to the recent drop in oil prices. Staff recommends that the Public Works Director be authorized to issue contract change order(s) for additional paving work, up to \$400,000. This will enable the City to take advantage of the low bid prices. This additional paving may include extended work on Pine Street, Center Avenue, Arnold Drive, the Virginia Hills area and Glacier Drive.

**Fiscal Impact**

The project is budgeted under Account No. C1052. Funding for the 2015/16 Pavement Seal Coat project is also included in Account No. C1052. The project budget and funding is as follows:

**RESOLUTION NO. -15**

**ACCEPTING BIDS FOR THE 2015 PAVING PROJECT AND AWARDING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO MCK SERVICES INC.**

**WHEREAS**, the City has budgeted Gas Tax and Local Measure J funds for paving and pavement rehabilitation of local roads; and

**WHEREAS**, the City prepared plans, specifications and estimate for the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City advertised for bids from general engineering contractors for purposes of submitting bids for construction of the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 29, 2015, bids were publicly opened; and

**WHEREAS**, MCK Services, Inc. submitted the lowest responsible bid; and

**WHEREAS**, the lowest responsible bid is \$400,000 lower than the engineer's estimate for the work; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends the Public Works Director be authorized to issue contract change orders up to \$400,000 for additional paving work; and

**WHEREAS**, it is deemed in the best interest of the public and the City to implement the 2015 Paving Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Martinez, the bid from MCK Services, Inc., is hereby accepted when the required performance bond, labor and materials bond, insurance and other contract documents have been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for said project with the contractor.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Public Works Director is authorized to issue contract change orders up to \$400,000 for additional paving work.

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
