Over the weekend I received an email from a friend of mine who is coaching in Martinez Little League. Recently when he has attempted to use the field he has observed dog owners using the field to walk their dogs. His children have also stepped in dog feces when they've been playing at the field. I know that the City policy is that dogs are not allowed on the field, but apparently this isn't posted at Borman. Can we post a sign at Borman stating the City policy of no dogs on the field? Also there is a homeless encampment past the center field fence.

Also, he had attempted to contact the City directly through the City's website but his email was returned with an error message. Please let me know about posting the field, or who else from the City I can contact about these issues. Thanks Tim. Below is his email to me.

"Hello Dylan

I sent the following on the submit section of the mtz website but it came back error three times. If you know someone to pass this on since I can't confirm it was sent because of the error message.

"I am a coach for the Martinez Little League. Borman Field(Mountain View Park) will be where we will practice and play games. Each time we go there there are people with multiple dogs inside the baseball field running on the field and in the grass. Can city personnel put the two signs up for No Dogs allowed on the field and no dogs off leash. Currently there is no signage around the field. One of my kids stepped in piles of dog feces. It is a real shame dog owners don't respect the kids. A passerby says there is one particular lady with 10 plus dogs that lets them all loose on the field. Also there is garbage or homeless encampment over the centerfield fence between the chain link and wood fence. Any help would be greatly appreciated. Thank You."
