Recommendation

Adopt resolution accepting bids for the 2015-16 Pavement Rehabilitation Project (C1052) and awarding the construction contract to VSS International, Inc., West Sacramento CA, in the amount of \$759,000.


Background

On October 7, 2015 the City Council awarded the 2015 Paving Project to MCK Services. The project included patch paving in anticipation of resurfacing. Although the City is still awaiting approval from Caltrans to complete the work at Highway 4 the patch paving has been completed. Due to favorable bids the Council authorized the Public Works Director to increase the scope of the paving contract. Additional streets in Virginia Hills and the Rolling Hills neighborhoods were added. These areas were chosen based on the proximity to other work, condition of the roadways and fitting the criteria for rubberized cape seal treatment. Lastly, the Arriba Street right-of-way required emergency slide repair last fall. Gas tax funds in C1052 are being transferred to fund the repair.

Discussion

Construction bids from four general engineering contractors were opened at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 29, 2016. The bids ranged from \$759,000 to \$1,008,008. The engineer's estimate was \$869,000. The following is a summary of the bid results:

VSS International, Inc., of West Sacramento is the lowest responsible bidder. They are properly licensed and have successfully completed several projects for the City and other local agencies.

It is recommended the project be awarded to VSS International, Inc., in the amount of \$759,000. The lowest responsible bid is over \$100,000 lower than the engineer's estimate in large part to the recent drop in oil prices and because the project was designed to take one full week for the rubber chip. This eliminates wasted workdays for the contractor between projects. Remaining funds in Account C1052 will roll over for the FY 2016-17 Annual Pavement Program.

Fiscal Impact

The project is budgeted under Account No. C1052. Funding for the 2015/16 Pavement Seal Coat project is also included in Account No. C1052. The project budget and funding is as follows:

**ACCEPTING BIDS FOR THE 2015-16 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT (C1052) AND
AWARDING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO VSS INTERNATIONAL, INC., WEST
SACRAMENTO CA, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$759,000**

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted Gas Tax and Local Measure J funds for paving and pavement rehabilitation of local roads; and

WHEREAS, the City prepared plans, specifications and estimate for the 2015-16 Pavement Rehabilitation Project (C1052); and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids from general engineering contractors for purposes of submitting bids for construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on March 29, 2016, bids were publicly opened; and

WHEREAS, VSS International, Inc. submitted the lowest responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bid is within budget at \$759,000; and

WHEREAS, the Arreba Street right-of-way required emergency repair this past fall and \$34,753 in gas tax funds in C1052 are being transferred to the fund the work; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the public and the City to implement the 2015-16 Pavement Rehabilitation Project (C1052).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Martinez that the bid from VSS International, Inc. is hereby accepted when the required performance bond, labor and materials bond, insurance and other contract documents have been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for said project with the contractor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Finance Manager is authorized to transfer \$34,753 from account C1052 to fund the Arreba Street Emergency Slide Repair.

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
