Dear Mayor Schroder:

According to our records, your agency needs to make an appointment to the Contra Costa County Library Commission for the term of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2010 for a Commission member and alternate, if so desired. Your current appointee to the Contra Costa County Library Commission is Kathy Fuller and the alternate position is vacant. Your appointee's term can be re-authorized for this period or a new appointment for a member and an alternate (if so desired) may be made.

The Library Commission met twelve times during the past two years. A record of attendance for your current appointee is attached for your information.

Included with this letter are the current Contra Costa County Library Commission By-Laws, along with the May 2, 2006 Board of Supervisors' Board Order and a June 2, 2006 letter from the Mayors' Conference both reauthorizing the Library Commission for five more years, through June 30, 2011.

Currently the Commission meets every other month, on the fourth Thursday evening at 7pm. As the Contra Costa County Library looks to better serve the needs of its increasingly ethnically and culturally diverse constituency, the ability of the Library Commission to reflect this diversity will be extremely important.
