SUBJECT: 2008-09 Curb Ramp Installation Project
DATE: October 25, 2008

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt resolution accepting bids for the City's 2008-09 Curb Ramp Installation Project and awarding the construction contract to Don Jose Concrete, Inc.

BACKGROUND:

The 2008-09 Curb Ramp Installation Project will construct fifteen access curb ramps at the following street intersections: Castro Street and "D" Street; Walnut Ave and South Castro Street; Vista Way and Pine Street; and Vista Way and Palm Ave.

On July 16, 2008, the City Council allocated \$25,000 of Gas Tax funds for this project and authorized the City Manager to execute an agreement with the Contra Costa County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program to provide \$20,000 for this project.

Eighteen Bids were opened at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 23, 2008 for the construction of subject project. Don Jose Concrete Inc. of Fremont, California, was the low bidder. The following is a list of bids for the lowest five bidders:

- Don Jose Concrete Inc. \$ 35,800.00
- Victor Concrete \$ 41,000.00
- Murga, Strange & Chalmers \$ 44,891.00
- Ameca General Engineering \$ 47,000.00
- Acequia Cement \$ 47,090.00

The Engineers estimate is \$45,930. Don Jose Concrete Inc. has successfully completed the construction of sidewalks and curb ramps in the Cities of Los Altos, South San Francisco, and Santa Clara. A check of their references provided favorable responses.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The estimated total budget for this project is \$45,000, which includes construction, contingencies, design, material testing, and construction management. The City is eligible to receive \$20,000 from the Contra Costa County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program for the construction of this project. There is currently \$25,000 budgeted under account number C1010 for this project.

RESOLUTION NO. -08

AWARDING A CONTRACT TO DON JOSE CONCRETE INC. FOR THE CITY OF MARTINEZ 2008-09 CURB RAMP INSTALLATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2008, the Council authorized the allocation of \$25,000 for the 2008-09 Curb Ramp Installation Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has executed an agreement with the Contra Costa Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program to receive \$20,000 for this Project as authorized by the City Council on July 16, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City did advertise for bids from general engineering contractors; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2008, eighteen (18) bids were publicly opened; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the public and the City to implement the 2008-09 Curb Ramp Installation Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Martinez that:

- A) The bid of Don Jose Concrete Inc. is hereby accepted in an amount of \$35,800 when the required performance bond, labor and materials bond, insurance and other contract documents have been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for said project with the contractor.
- B) Should Don Jose Concrete Inc. fails to deliver all contract documents, fully executed and filled out, so that they are in the hands of the City within ten calendar days after receipt of notice from the City of the City's acceptance of their bid, then the bid shall be deemed in violation of the contract documents and the bid shall be deemed non-responsive and rejected and the second lowest responsible bidder shall be awarded the contract to complete the project.



ACCESS RAMPS LOCATION MAP




