SUBJECT: 2009 Sidewalk Replacement Project
DATE: September 28, 2009

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt resolution accepting bids for the City's 2009 Sidewalk Replacement Project and awarding the construction contract to Nor-Cal Concrete Inc.

DISCUSSION:

The 2009 Sidewalk Replacement Project will replace approximately 5,445 square feet of damaged sidewalk and four new curb ramps at various residential locations in downtown Martinez. The project includes portions of Court, Susana, Castro, Jones, Estudillo and Arriba Streets (see attached is a location map.)

On July 15, 2009, the City Council authorized the City Manager to execute an agreement with the Contra Costa County Community Development Block Grant under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 Program (CDBG-R) to receive \$40,000 toward this project. In addition the Council allocated \$30,000 of Gas Tax funds for this project.

Sixteen bids were opened at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 24, 2009 for the construction of this project. Nor-Cal Concrete of Suisun, California, was the low bidder. The following is a list of lowest five bidders:

- Nor-Cal Concrete \$ 48,480.75
- R.A.M Concete \$ 48,894.50
- Malachi Construction \$ 48,901.25
- J.J.R. Construction, Inc. \$ 53,477.10
- Murga, Strange & Chalmers, Inc. \$ 54,175.00

The Engineer's Estimate was \$54,300.

Nor-Cal Concrete has successfully completed the construction of sidewalks and curb ramps in the cities of Dixon, Napa and Davis. A check of their references provided favorable responses.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The estimated total budget for this project is approximately \$68,500, which includes construction, contingencies, design, material testing, and construction management. The City is eligible to receive \$40,000 from the Contra Costa County Community Development Block Grant under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 program (CDBG-R) for the construction of this project. There is currently \$30,000 budgeted under account number C1040 for this project.

The estimated total budget as follows:

Total	\$70,000

A portion of the contingency will be used to install an additional curb ramp on Susana Street near the new Administration building.

Adopt resolution awarding a construction contract to Nor-Cal Concrete Inc. for the City of Martinez 2009 Sidewalk Replacement Project.



RESOLUTION NO. -09

**AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO NOR-CAL CONCRETE INC.
FOR THE CITY OF MARTINEZ 2009 SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, on JULY 15, 2009, the Council authorized the allocation of \$30,000 for the 2009 Sidewalk Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has executed an agreement with the Contra Costa Community Development Block Grant Under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (CDBG-R) program to receive \$40,000 for this Project as authorized by the City Council on JULY 15, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City did advertise for bids from general engineering contractors; and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2009, sixteen (16) bids were publicly opened; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the public and the City to implement the 2009 Sidewalk Replacement Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Martinez that:

- A) The bid of Nor-Cal Concrete is hereby accepted in an amount of \$48,480.75 when the required performance bond, labor and materials bond, insurance and other contract documents have been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for said project with the contractor.

- B) Should Nor-Cal Concrete fails to deliver all contract documents, fully executed and filled out, so that they are in the hands of the City within ten calendar days after receipt of notice from the City of the City's acceptance of their bid, then the bid shall be deemed in violation of the contract documents and the bid shall be deemed non-responsive and rejected and the second lowest responsible bidder shall be awarded the contract to complete the project.


