SUBJECT: Pool Subcommittee update

RECOMMENDATION:

Accept report.

BACKGROUND:

Pool designer Ken Moeller with Arch Pac has provided staff with a material sample board which shows the color and texture of major building elements. The Subcommittee is scheduled to review the board on February 24th. Due to the staff report deadlines their comments are not incorporated in the report.

In addition to the material sample board the designer is developing a color rendition plan of the building. The subcommittee will be reviewing this plan on the 24th also. The color rendition and material sample board will be available for viewing at the Commission meeting if approved by the Subcommittee.

At the previous PRMCC meeting comments were received regarding using “Green Construction” best management practices. This was a topic of discussion prior to the selection of a designer. This topic was addressed during the interview process of potential designers. Solar power is not a viable option for heating or running the pool. The building is being designed to take advantage of natural lighting. The Subcommittee will continue to work with the designer on utilizing cost effective energy saving site lighting, energy efficient pumps and other equipment. The designer is working directly with PG&E on these issues.

An oral report of the subcommittee comments will be presented to the PRMCC.
