RE: Kelloggs – Walmart Award Update

City staff (Tim Tucker, Alex Stroup and Karen Majors) participated in a conference call this week with Jennifer Crossett of Gigunda, the firm managing the Kelloggs Frosted Flakes “Plant A Seed Field Makeover” program and Chad Olsen of Brickman, the landscaping firm that develops the scope of work and manages the construction of the field makeover. Based upon discussions with Walmart staff, city staff and a representative of the Martinez Little League, the following is a list of potential field and related improvements for consideration:

1. turf improvements
2. irrigation improvements
3. infield material replacement
4. batting cages
5. new or improved bleachers
6. roll up door for one score-keeper booth
7. electricity for both score-keeper booths

City staff recommended that work commence in mid June or after so as not to interrupt the current season and that the tot lot near both fields would be replaced this summer. The contractor will make a site visit in early to mid April and develop a scope that will be presented to the PRMCC at the May meeting.
