SUBJECT: Holiday Highlands Park approval

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve motion accepting recommendation of Park Subcommittee for the design of Holiday Highlands and authorize the Park Subcommittee to approve the final construction plans.

BACKGROUND:

The Parks Subcommittee has been working closely with the Landscape Architect and City staff to refine the park design. The amenities for the park include a new small scale bathroom and providing ADA accessibility. In addition the turf will be rehabilitated rehabilitation and drainage deficiencies corrected.

New play equipment was installed in 2004. Shade trees have been added along with a small shade screen in the play area. Paths will be realigned and benches and tables installed. New trees will line the walkways. Attached is a layout of the park.
