Subject: Mid July – Mid August Staff Report

ADULT SPORTS

- Men's D Summer League ended July with an eight team single elimination tournament. The winning team was the Schmohawks. Shake and Bake and All Out Baseball ended the season with exactly the same standings. A home run derby Friday, July 23 was used the tie breaker. Shake and Bake took the league title.
- Martinez PD sponsored an eight team area police department tournament, Saturday August 7. San Ramon took first and Martinez came in fourth.
- Coed Summer League ended August 10 with a double elimination tournament. Team Elite took the league title and the Championship.
- Registration for Fall Softball has begun. We are offering a Men's 35 and older/E League, Coed and Men's Open program. The fall program is a six week season with no play-offs.
- Church League continues to play at Waterfront and Tavan. Their season will end August 28 with a tournament.
- A Women's Tournament was held at Waterfront July 24. Twelve teams participated.

AQUATICS

- Group swim lessons continue at the high school through August 13 with a short one week session. This summer we have had 359 students participate in lessons.
- MCST ended practices for the season August 13.
- Lap swimming and Water Aerobics will end August 13. We continue to see six to eight lap swimmers and fourteen aerobics participants per day.
- Recreation cleared the pool of the last remaining items. The City of San Mateo took our handicap lift. Blackhawk Country Club took our 20 year old dive stand. PG & E shut off the power and gas. Rental equipment was returned to the vendors.
- Park Maintenance removed chemical controllers, booster pumps, and chemical feed pumps for cleaning and storage.
- The facility has been toured by numerous contractors interested in bidding on the new pool project.
- The swim team cleared out office and storage areas.
- The pool was maintained until mid-July. Central Sanitary District issued the city a permit to pump out the pool at 40 gallons a minute. Parks began pumping the pool out August 6 and expect to complete the pump out of all 220,000 gallons in two weeks.
- Staff is developing a list of supplies and equipment needed for start-up at the new facility. These are items not listed in the bid process or marked in document as provided by owner.

BROCHURE

- Staff is working on the Fall 2010 Activity Guide scheduling classes, activities and special events. The brochure is expected to be completed and downloaded to the City website by August 23.
- The following classes were held between July 15 and August 13: beginning violin 2; bowling 2; Superhero Cartoon Camp 4; gymnastics 2; tennis 16.

FIELD PERMITS

- Pleasant Hill/Martinez AYSO was given permits for Hidden Lakes, Waterfront Multi-Use, Golden Hills, Nancy Boyd, Holiday Highlands, Mt View, Morello, and Hidden Valley for the fall season.
- Diablo Coed Soccer League was given permits for Hidden Lakes and Waterfront Multi-use Sunday mornings for an adult soccer program.
- Martinez Youth Football was permitted Waterfront Multi-use for the month of August for practices.
- Sorcerer's Girls Fastpitch Traveling Team was given a one day permit for try-out at Tavan

LASTING IMPRESSIONS PRESCHOOL

- The Director is currently accepting enrollment for the fall program. She currently has 11 children enrolled at this time.

SUMMER PLAYGROUND/DAY CAMP PROGRAM

- Nancy Boyd Playground Program came to a close August 13. Daily program attendance averaged around thirty children. Drop-in registration continued to popular. Parents loved the flexibility of dropping off the children on the days the needed or wanted supervised activities. Over a hundred twenty children participated in this camp.
- Nancy Boyd Playground participated in the Monday morning movies at the Contra Costa Cinemas. Two to three van loads of children would enjoy a movie and popcorn for \$5. Nature Camp had seventy-nine children enrolled Children participated in hikes, crafts, games, swim lessons, swimming, magic shows and more.
- Eurosoccer Skills Camp was held at Hidden Lakes August 9-13. We are still waiting for a final numbers count from Eurosoccer.
- The following soccer camps were held at Hidden Lakes NASC Soccer Camp, July 26-30; UK Soccer Camp August 2 – 6. These camps rent the facility and work through AYSO.

SPECIAL EVENTS

- Marty O's Movie Night was held at Nancy Boyd Park. Forty-one people braved the cold to watch "The SpongeBob Square Pants Movies." In true recreation fashion, the evening ended wildly when the sprinklers and proceeded to soak the crowd and equipment. Next week we will show "Cats and Dogs."
- Restaurant Tour will be held October 9. Robin Agostino and Barbara Patchin have worked very hard to secure eighteen restaurants to participate in this great activity.

YOUTH SPORTS

- Recreation registered with the NFL Youth Sports to hold a Punt, Pass and Kick Competition in September.
- Staff is preparing the week for a large regional baseball tournament held at all five Waterfront Fields. The tournament is a two day event and will include twenty-four teams in four age brackets.
- Mini Kickers Soccer an instructional soccer program for preschoolers ended August 9..
