Subject: Park Maintenance Update for October

Parks

Repaired lights, hot wheel track and bridge at Holiday Highlands Park. Main leak was repaired at Cappy Ricks Park. Hazard tree was removed, trees were pruned, wood was repaired around play area, restroom was painted and lights repaired at Cappy Ricks Park. Main leak was repaired at John Muir. Blown down tree was removed at Ferry Point. A table top was replaced and a homeless camp was removed from Golden Hills Park. Sod was installed, grass was seeded and irrigation repaired around play area at Hidden Lakes Park. Tripping hazards removed from asphalt at Hidden Lakes Park.

Public Facilities

Mulch was installed at Amtrak Station; Mulch was installed at the Amphitheatre; trees were pruned on Main Street.

Medians, Roadsides

Lights were repaired on Hospice Tree; Arundo (giant cane) was removed along Alhambra Ave; trees were pruned on Vine Hill, Douglas Dr. and Alhambra Way.

Open Space

Large amount of chip was spread at Golden Hills Park; algae treatment was added to Hidden Lakes pond; cleaned v ditches.
