BACKGROUND

The Library Subcommittee met on March and received update on the progress of the library construction activities and plans and discussed casual use of the downstairs. The casual use of the downstairs subcommittee discussion is included in the Casual Use of the Library Downstairs report under Old Business.

Dave Scola, Public Works Director that the project is going along well. The project is still on time and under budget. He also disclosed that the project included installation of cameras based on concerns library staff had about the downstairs. Additionally Dave confirmed that the downstairs will have the ability to be secured from the upstairs so uses of these upstairs and downstairs could take place independent of one another.

Soon a project meeting between the County and City will occur to discuss installation of new technical equipment and furniture for the library.
