RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt resolution accepting bids for the 2010-11 Paving Project, and awarding the construction contract to Bay Cities Paving and Grading, Inc. in an amount of \$555,537.00

BACKGROUND:

Three bids were opened at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 19, 2011, for this project. Bay Cities Paving and Grading, Inc., of Concord, California, was the lowest responsible bidder. The following is a list of bids:

Engineer's Estimate	\$700,000.00

The bids were below the Engineer's Estimate. The bids ranged from a low of \$555,537.00 from Bay Cities Paving and Grading, Inc. to \$649,985 for the high bidder and are within allocated funding. Bay Cities Paving and Grading, Inc. has successfully completed similar work for Martinez and surrounding cities.

The 2010-11 Paving Project includes pavement repair and overlay of Main Street from Castro Street to Court Street, Shell Avenue from Castro Street to Pine Street and Muir Road from Glacier Drive to the city limits near Pacheco Boulevard.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The funding for the project is Proposition 42, Traffic Congestion Relief (TCR) funds, Gas Tax funds, and local Measure C funds. The TCR funds must be spent within one year, or by June 30, 2011. The TCR funds, including any accrued interest will be expended before the other funding sources. The 2010-11 Paving Project is budgeted under Account No. C1043. The project budget is sufficient to fully fund the project. Any remaining fund balance will be rolled into the subsequent paving project (Account C1044).

RESOLUTION NO. -11

ADOPT RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BIDS FOR THE 2010-11 PAVING PROJECT
AND AWARDING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO
BAY CITIES PAVING AND GRADING INC. IN AN AMOUNT OF \$555,537

WHEREAS, the City has obtained Proposition 42, Gas Tax and local Measure C funds for paving and pavement rehabilitation of local roads; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids from general engineering contractors; and

WHEREAS, bids were publicly opened on April 19, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Bay Cities Paving and Grading Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the public and the City to implement the 2010-11 Paving Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Martinez that the bid from Bay Cities Paving and Grading Inc. is hereby accepted in the amount of \$555,537.00 when the required performance bond, labor and materials bond, insurance and other contract documents have been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for said project with the contractor; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should Bay Cities Paving and Grading Inc. fail to deliver all contract documents, fully executed and filled out, so that they are in the hands of the City within ten calendar days after receipt of notice from the City of the City's acceptance of their bid, then the bid shall be deemed in violation of the contract documents and the bid shall be deemed non-responsive and rejected and the second lowest responsible bidder shall be awarded the contract to complete the project.
