RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt resolution accepting the 2010-2011 Paving Project per contract documents and instruct the City Clerk to file a Notice of Completion.

BACKGROUND:

Work consisted of asphalt concrete overlays on Main Street from Court to Castro and from Alhambra to Talbart, Shell Avenue from Pine to Castro, and Muir Road from Glacier to the City limits. The project also included traffic control, pavement grinding, pavement repairs, crack sealing, adjustment of utilities, and replacement of pavement striping and markings.

On May 5, 2011, a contract was awarded to Bay Cities Paving and Grading, Inc. for construction of the subject project as per contract plans and specifications for a total bid amount of \$555,537.00. Two Contract Change Orders for a total sum of \$78,698.02 were issued. Change Order # 1 was issued to extend the paving on Main Street West of Alhambra Ave to Talbart Street. Staff had received many complaints on the conditions of the pavement in this area of town. Upon review of the poor condition of the existing street, it made sense to extend limits of the work to capture these failed areas under this project. The second change order was to provide portable message boards that advise the public of the scheduled work that was to be performed. The final total price including said change orders and based on actual field measurements of constructed improvements is \$634,235.02.

Below is a summary of the Contact Change Orders. Funding for the change orders came from the project contingency.

C.O. 1	Asphalt concrete overlay on Main Street from Alhambra to Talbart and crack sealing.	\$77,478.42
C.O. 2	Rent changeable message board per City’s direction.	\$1,219.60

The Contractor has submitted the Contractor Guarantee and the Maintenance Bond, and agrees to correct any defects as per specifications for a one-year period.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The funding for the project was previously allocated Proposition 42, Traffic Congestion Relief funds (\$331,107), Gas Tax funds (\$135,000) and local Measure C funds.

Motion to adopt a resolution and file a Notice of Completion for 2010-2011 Paving Project.
