**RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt resolutions:

1. Accepting bids for the Sports Court Resurfacing Project and awarding the construction contract to Vintage Contractors Inc.
2. Allocating an additional \$240,500 of Measure H Funds to Account No. C5019 for construction of the Sports Court Resurfacing Project.

**BACKGROUND:**

On December 15, 2010 the City Council allocated funds for the design of Phase 2 Measure H projects which included the Sports Court Resurfacing Project. Plans were completed and staff advertised for bids starting March 20, 2012. The project includes repairing and resurfacing of basketball and tennis courts at six different parks in the City. The work includes but is not limited to: repairing of cracks, applying new acrylic surfacing, striping, tree removal, fence modifications, site furnishings, constructing concrete ramps, stairways and handrail, and asphalt paving. In addition the work includes the repair of the concrete path at Foothill Park.

One bid was opened at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 10, 2012, for the Sports Court Resurfacing Project. Vintage Contractors Inc., of San Francisco, California, was the lowest responsible bidder. Their bid was for \$251,873 which exceeded the Engineer's Estimate of \$242,581 by approximately \$9,300 or 4%.

Vintage Contractors Inc. has an active C12 Contractor's License as required by the specifications. They have successfully constructed several other similar projects for other agencies in the Bay Area.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The project is budgeted under Account No. C5019. The funding for the project is Measure H. The Council had allocated funds for design phase of the Phase 2 Measure H projects. The Council will need to allocate construction funding for the project to move forward.

AND AWARDING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO  
VINTAGE CONTRACTORS INC.

**WHEREAS**, the Council allocated funds for the design of the Measure H Park projects, Phase 2 on December 15, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is identified in the adopted Park System Master Plan (2007-2012); and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is listed as a Measure H project, Phase 2; and

**WHEREAS**, the City advertised for bids from general contractors with Class A and/or C12 and/or C32 license; and

**WHEREAS**, bids were publicly opened on April 10, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, Vintage Contractors Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder; and

**WHEREAS**, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the public and the City to implement the Sports Court Resurfacing Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Martinez that the bid from Vintage Contractors Inc. is hereby accepted in the amount of \$251,873 when the required performance bond, labor and materials bond, insurance and other contract documents have been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for said project with the contractor.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that should Vintage Contractors Inc. fail to deliver all contract documents, fully executed and filled out, so that they are in the hands of the City within ten calendar days after receipt of notice from the City of the City's acceptance of their bid, then the bid shall be deemed in violation of the contract documents and the bid shall be deemed non-responsive and rejected.
