SUBJECT: Waterfront Park Picnic Area Upgrades

**ACTION**

Move to approve staff's recommendation to purchase and refurbish picnic areas at Waterfront Park.

**BACKGROUND**

Waterfront Park has two large group picnic areas (see attach aerial). The north area is under the pavilion. The previous tables were made of expanded metal that was subject to vandalism. These tables were removed approximately five years ago. This area houses 12 tables. Staff proposes to move twelve tables from Rankin Park to the Waterfront Pavilion area and replace them with tables with umbrella holders. The concrete tables look good, are reasonably priced and hold up well to use and abuse. Two matching trash cans would also be installed.

In addition Park Maintenance Staff requests to refurbish the wood picnic tables and benches at the Bocce Group Picnic area. This is a popular picnic area. The tables are approximately 20 years old and due for replacement. The metal supports are in good shape and will not need to be replaced making the refurbishment manageable by staff.

It is anticipated the total cost of the material to be \$30,000 and would be purchased with Measure H funds.
