***Sports Court Resurfacing Project:***

All work completed. Staff continues to receive compliments from the community on a routine basis.

***Park Projects (Hidden Valley, Nancy Boyd and Cappy Ricks):***

As the design of Hidden Valley Project is nearing completion staff is evaluating the advantages of bidding all three park projects in one contract. Some of the advantages are:

1. Work is similar at all projects
2. Only one bid package will need to be developed
3. A larger more competent contracting firm is likely to be awarded a project.
4. Project/Construction management will be streamlined.
5. Total costs will be reduced.

***Pool Signage Update:***

The City Council and PRMCC received a request from a resident who lives near the park. The resident specifically requested the City evaluate creating a four way stop, where only a two way stop existed, at Buckley and Talbert Streets along with placing a directional sign to additional parking at upper Rankin Park. The Engineering division evaluated the warrants for the additional stop and agreed to placing stop and stop ahead signage. These signs have been in place for approximately three weeks. Staff has ordered the "additional parking" sign. Staff was notified it would be ready for pick up on 9/14. The sign will be installed once it is available.
