SUBJECT: Measure H Status Update

RECOMMENDATION:

DISCUSSION:

The Parks subcommittee recently met with Dave Lusty, Parks Supervisor to discuss existing park deficiencies and potential upcoming project priorities. The subcommittee agreed that Waterfront Park must be considered a high priority project. Staff believes that remaining funding could be used to address ADA access, safety issues and existing park deficiencies. Some of the projects discussed were:

1. Waterfront Park
2. The installation of an all weather field at Hidden Lakes Park
3. Roof and fixture replacement at Hidden Lakes Park concession/restroom building.
4. Non compliant play equipment replacement at Mt. View and Highland Avenue Parks.
5. Restroom/community room replacement at Golden Hills Park.
6. Pathway replacement at Susana Street Park.

The Parks Subcommittee will discuss these potential priorities and develop a formal recommendation to the full PRMCC in the near future.
