
BACKGROUND

The Dog Park subcommittee is scheduled to meet on January 14, 2013, after the writing of this report. The subcommittee is focusing on developing the south-eastern portion of the Alhambra Avenue Detention Basin as a dog park. The subcommittee is scheduled to review the plans of the basin and evaluate the size of potential fenced areas that will fit the site. If the site is determined adequate for a dog park the preliminary layouts will be presented to Maintenance and Public Works staff for input.

The City is initiating a review of the Park Master Plan. It is hoped that any PRMCC recommendation for designating a site for a dog park will be incorporated into the update.

Tasks:

1. Review other dog parks. (Completed)
2. Determine minimum and maximum area and other design criteria (completed)
3. Develop a preferred location (pending PRMCC approval)
4. Review locations with Park Maintenance Staff and Supervisors
5. CEQA Compliance
6. PRMCC approval to amend Park Master Plan to include a dog park.
7. City Council approval of Master Plan amendment
8. Inclusion into CIP
9. Fund and construct
