
DISCUSSION:

The Parks Subcommittee met on February 5, 2013 to discuss the Water Front Park Renovation project. The PRMCC has designated this project as the highest priority project to begin design. Because of the scale and complexity of the design the Subcommittee has recommended completing a limited advertised Request for Qualifications (RFQ). The Subcommittee's goal is to find the best available Landscape Architect to be paired with the civil engineering firm LCC. Once the RFQ's are received and ranked the top Landscape Architect firms will be interviewed. The PRMCC will eventually forward a recommendation to the City Council on entering into a design contract with the preferred firm.

The Subcommittee discussed the limits and scope of the project. The limits of the project will include:

1. Ball fields (including soccer field)
2. Ball field Concession/Restroom structure. (Bocce restroom replacement is a current project to be constructed this spring.)
3. Parking lots (3)
4. Group and other picnic areas
5. Lawn area
6. Play equipment surfacing (equipment need not be replaced)
7. Skate Park fencing
8. Lawn area and paths

The subcommittee will take a fresh look at the park layout and not be constrained by the current configuration.
