SUBJECT: Reliez Valley Road Paving Project
DATE: April 25, 2013

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt resolution accepting bids for the Reliez Valley Road Paving Project and awarding the construction contract to MCK Services Inc. in the amount of \$640,213.50.

BACKGROUND:

Bids were opened at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 25, 2013, for this project. MCK Services Inc., of Martinez, California, was the lowest responsible bidder. The following is a list of bids:

MCK Services Inc.	\$640,213.50
Bay Cities Paving and Grading, Inc.	\$692,320.60
Engineer's Estimate	\$750,000.00

The bids were below the Engineer's Estimate. The bids ranged from a low of \$640,213.50 from MCK Services Inc. to \$692,320.60 for the high bidder and are within allocated funding. MCK Services Inc. has successfully completed several similar projects for Martinez and other surrounding cities.

The Reliez Valley Road Paving Project includes pavement repair and overlay of all of Reliez Valley Road within the city limits, which is just under a mile long. Also included are pavement repairs in the Virginia Hills neighborhood. The project is tentatively scheduled to start May 20 and be completed within 30 days. Daily lane closures of Reliez Valley Road will be required when constructions operations are in progress. Flaggers will direct traffic around the work zone. It is expected that delays will be less than five minutes. Message boards will be installed to advise motorists of the construction.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The funding for the project is Proposition 1B and local Measure J funds. The Proposition 1B funds must be spent by June 30, 2013. The Proposition funds, including any accrued interest will be expended before the other funding sources. The Reliez Valley Road Paving Project is budgeted under Account No. C1046. The project budget is sufficient to fully fund the project. Any surplus funds will be transferred to Account No. C1044 for the 2013 Paving Project.



RESOLUTION NO. -13

ACCEPTING BIDS FOR THE RELIEZ VALLEY ROAD PAVING PROJECT AND
AWARDING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO MCK SERVICES, INC.
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$640,213.50

WHEREAS, the City has obtained Proposition 1B and Local Measure J funds for paving and pavement rehabilitation of local roads; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids from general engineering contractors; and

WHEREAS, bids were publicly opened on April 25, 2013; and

WHEREAS, MCK Services Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the public and the City to implement the Reliez Valley Road Paving Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Martinez that the bid from MCK Services Inc. is hereby accepted in the amount of \$640,213.50 when the required performance bond, labor and materials bond, insurance and other contract documents have been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for said project with the contractor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should MCK Services Inc. fail to deliver all contract documents, fully executed and filled out, so that they are in the hands of the City within ten calendar days after receipt of notice from the City of the City's acceptance of their bid, then the bid shall be deemed in violation of the contract documents and the bid shall be deemed non-responsive and rejected and Bay Cities Paving and Grading Inc. shall be awarded the contract to complete the project.

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




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Reliez Valley Road
