RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Ordinance No. 1372 C.S. amending Title 10, Vehicles and Traffic, Chapter 10.36.060, of the Municipal Code relating to Parking Meter Fees.

BACKGROUND:

At the City Council meeting of September 4, the above ordinance was introduced and a public hearing was held in accordance with California Government Code. The ordinance is now before you for adoption and will become effective after 30 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No fiscal impact; the proposed ordinance amendment does not change parking meter rates or revenues.

ACTION:

Motion to adopt Ordinance No. 1372 C.S. amending Title 10, Vehicles and Traffic, Chapter 10.36.060, of the Municipal Code relating to Parking Meter Fees.

ORDINANCE NO. 1372 C.S.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARTINEZ AMENDING
TITLE 10, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, CHAPTER 10.36.060, OF THE
MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO PARKING METER FEES

The City Council of the City of Martinez does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

Chapter 10.36.060 of Title 10 of the City of Martinez Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.36.060 - Fees.

Parking meter fees within the established parking meter zones (Section 10.36.020) shall be no greater than ~~\$.50~~ **\$1.00** per hour for all meters. All meters, with the exception of loading/unloading zones, shall have a ~~minimum time limit of 2 hours,~~ and maximum time limit of 10 hours. Meters for loading/unloading zones shall have a maximum time limit of 30 minutes. The exact meter rates and durations shall be set by ~~resolution~~ **ordinance**.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this and each section, subsection, phrase or clause thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, phrase or clauses be declared unconstitutional on their face or as applied.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after the date of adoption.

SECTION 4. Posting. At least five (5) days prior to its final adoption, a certified copy of the full text of this ordinance shall be posted in the office of the City Clerk.

Within 15 days after adoption the City Clerk shall publish a summary of this ordinance with the names of those City Council members voting for and against the ordinance in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City of Martinez.

The City Clerk shall post in the office of the City Clerk a certified copy of the full text of the adopted ordinance.
